IS THIS COURSE RECOGNISED?

This course is fully accredited by the Australian National Training Authority (ANTA) and Sport and recreation Australia (SRTA) and the Office of Training and Tertiary Education (OTTO). This training package is also accepted as a recognised qualification with the Martial Arts Industry Association (MAIA).

MELBOURNE MARTIAL ARTS ACADEMY

Head instructor Shihan George Kolovos, with more than 30 years experience, is one of the most successful martial arts instructors and a leader in the industry. He was awarded the 2002 Blitz Karate Instructor of the year. He produced the first Australian world champion and has produced countless Australian and Victorian champions. He is a qualified full contact Karate and Kickboxing referee, refereeing in all events around the state. He is a licensed promoter, promoting some of the biggest full contact Karate and Kickboxing events in Victoria.

He is the founder of World Ring Karate Australia (WRKA) producing shows with a high level of fighting and entertainment with a DJ, ring announcer, flashing lights and all the glamour fighters require, as they are the show.

In June 2002 he was certified by the Thai Ministry of Education as an official martial arts and kick boxing training provider.

Having the opportunity to train with him or one of his instructors will make you understand why MKK is leading the martial arts industry in Australia.

On October 14th 1998, World Ring Karate Australia (WRKA) was registered and is recognised by the Boxing and Martial Arts Board as a leader in promoting full contact karate. It is only through this regular active competition that Melbourne Kyokushin Karate has kept its fighters on top of the Australian full contact karate circuit. WRKA gives the fighters the opportunity to train and fight with all the glamour and hype that comes with kick boxing, giving the fighter the profile and not the event.

Following on from the WRKA success story, in Oct 2004 Shihan George launched Brute Force Promotions, launching Melbourne Martial Arts Academy into the Thai Boxing arena. Brute Force Promotions has gone from strength to strength being the only promoter in Victoria offering quality Thai Boxing shows up to 4 times a year. Brute Force Promotions gives spectators of the sport the opportunity to see both international and interstate fighters in their home town.

DESCRIPTION

This training package provides education and training for people who are either currently working in or those who wish to work in the martial arts industry as an instructor or coach. These qualifications are particularly directed to those wishing to establish a career in the industry. The qualifications include but are not limited to the various systems of Karate, Aikido, Judo, Jiu Jitsu, Taekwondo, Kung-Fu, Ninjutsu and Kickboxing. This exciting training package also deals with the latest qualifications for instructors, teaching martial arts weaponry including padded weapons, wooden or blunt weapons, steel or live edged weapons.

This course may be completed in conjunction with your training in Kyokushin Karate and Titans Kickboxing Muay Thai.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

This training package has no formal entrance requirements. Applicants must be able to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the College and their martial arts instructor that they are capable of completing the course having regard to the relevant competence levels consistent with the Australian Qualifications Framework and their chosen martial arts system.

SELECTION PROCEDURES

Applicants should demonstrate a commitment to the martial arts industry and have an awareness of the role of the industry in the community.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Skills acquired are consistent with the requirements for many roles in the sports and martial arts leadership industry.

QUALIFICATIONS

Participants will be awarded Certificate III, IV or Diploma of Sport Coaching (Martial Arts) upon successful completion of the relevant units of competence.

WHAT WILL THE COURSE COVER?

This course covers a range of competencies at AQF level III, IV and Diploma.

TRAINING

Your training in the course will consist of at least 8 hours a week of training in the martial art of your choice: Kyokushin Karate or Titans Muay Thai (kick boxing) as well as a gym workout.

All workouts will be monitored and attendance at all events such as tournaments, seminars, camps etc is compulsory to maximise your knowledge in a short period of time. MKK has a proven teaching method.

HOW MUCH WILL THE COURSE COST?

Certificate II & III Sport Coaching (Martial Arts)

13 months: \$2800 – includes all training fees, a karate or kickboxing kit, all tournament and grading fees for the term of the course and 12 personalised classes. This is equivalent to Green/Brown belt karate level or Brown Singlet in Thai Boxing—Assistant Instructor level.

Certificate IV in Sport Coaching (Martial Arts)

11 months: \$2800 – includes all training fees, all tournament and grading fees for the term of the course, 12 personalised classes and 1 training camp. This is equivalent to Black Belt in Karate or Black Singlet in Thai Boxing—Instructors Level.

Diploma in Sport Coaching (Martial Arts)

17 months: \$3650 – includes all training fees, all tournament and grading fees for the term of the course, 12 personalised classes and all training camps and seminars. This is a Senior Instructors level, qualified to operate multiple schools, organise camps, tournaments etc and Event Management. The Diploma course is only offered to Senior Instructors with 5 years or more experience.

All fees are payable in advance or by direct debit, students electing direct debit option must pay \$500 deposit upon enrolling.
